### Preliminary Biology Field Trip

Last Friday, the Preliminary Biology Class comprised of students from 5 of the 6 Access schools, participated in an excursion to Darlington Point.

Students completed a field study of the River Red Gum Ecosystem found in the Murrumbidgee Valley National Park. Darron from the Riverina Environmental Education Centre taught us about the abiotic (non-living) and biotic (living) components of the ecosystem and how they interact with each other.

We conducted a number of tests on water and soil, as well as learnt about the different habitats found within the ecosystem. We had a great day of exploring and learning.
