Headlice

It has come to our attention that head lice are again causing a problem with our community's children. We ask that all parents and carers check their children's hair each day. If there appears to be head lice or 'nits' present then it is imperative that you treat your child/children's hair with an appropriate head lice treatment. This treatment should be followed up again seven days later. These treatments are available from the local chemist. If a school staff member suspects/sees your child has head lice they will be sent home and permitted to return to school after an appropriate treatment is completed.

Negative test results in the form of a screen shot of the app results **or** a letter from your GP must be emailed to lockhart-c.school@det.nsw.edu.au. The school will send acknowledgment via email/text to confirm that the test results have been received.

Please do not send your child back to school until they are symptom free and have a negative COVID-19 result that the school has received.

We recommend that you review NSW Health guidelines for any self-isolation requirements.

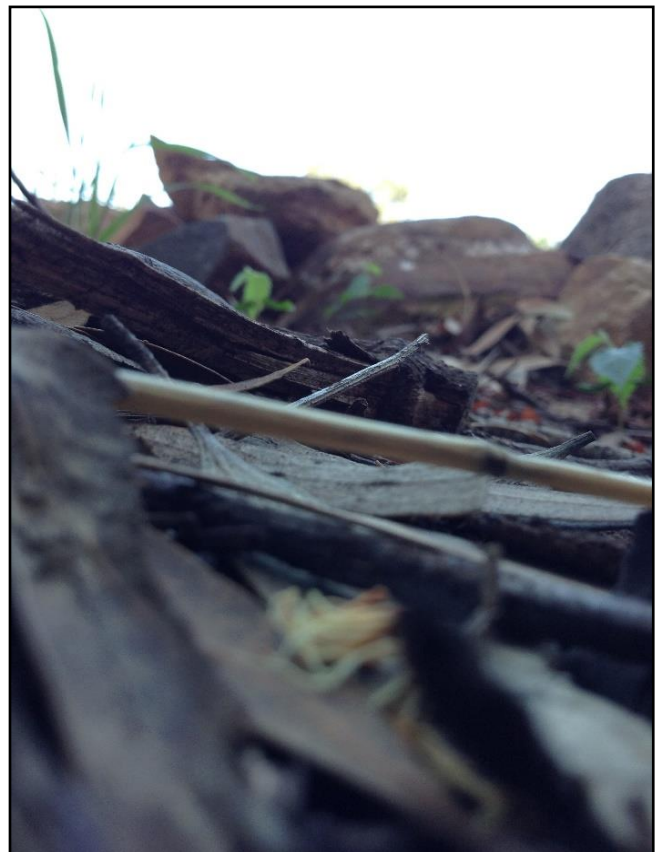
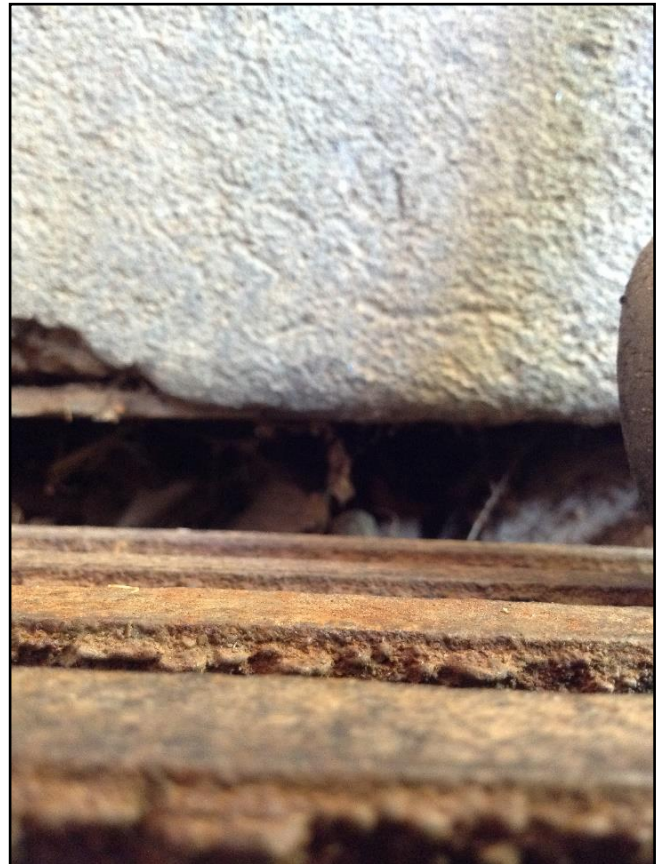
